

Building Your Project Resume

Why should anyone get involved in your project as a: • Funder, Board Member, Volunteer, etc

Create a "1 pager" for your project

Step 1:What is the project purpose/goal (30 words or less)
Step 2: List milestones and any project awards
Step 3: Identify project partners or "References"
Step 4: Make it compelling but concise (and PROOFREAD)
Step 5: Share, Share, Share
